Schedule AL-TOU Primary



Applicability:

Default rate for all non-residential customers whose monthly maximum demand equals, exceeds, or is expected to exceed 20 kW. Schedule AL-TOU is "optionally" available to customers whose maximum demand is below 20 kW.

Rates Effective 01/01/2012:

Customers receive metered electric service at SDG&E's distribution level. Primary customers own and maintain the transformer.
