## Schedule AL-TOU Secondary



### Applicability:

Default rate for all non-residential customers whose monthly maximum demand equals, exceeds, or is expected to exceed 20 kW. Schedule AL-TOU is "optionally" available to customers whose maximum demand is below 20 kW.

### Rates Effective 09/01/2009:

Customers who receive metered electric service after the voltage has been reduced from SDG&E's distribution level.
