Applicability:

Applicable to Low-Income single-phase domestic (residential) service for lighting, heating, cooking, water heating, and power, or combination thereof, in single family dwellings that are separately metered by the utility. A 20% CARE discount will be applied to all CARE electric charges billed on this schedule. In addition, customers on this schedule will be exempt from paying the CARE Surcharge of \$0.00241 kWh.

Low-Income Household is where the total annual gross income from all sources is no more than what is shown in the table below: **(revised effective 06/01/08)**
