Applicability:

Natural gas service for individually metered residential customers.

Also applicable to natural gas service used in common for residential purposes in a multi-family dwelling, such as: swimming pool/spa heating, laundry room, recreation-hall space and/or water heating, and cooking.

Intrastate transportation-only service option is provided to core GR customers on Schedule GTC/GR.

The "Total" rate for customers who receive full gas service on GR from SDG&E is a combination of Schedule GTC (gas transportation core) and Schedule GPC (gas procurement core). Schedule GPC includes a Brokerage Fee of \$0.00095 per therm. Transportation-only customers avoid all of Schedule GPC with the exception of Franchise Fees, which are billed on Schedule GP-SUR. During the 2005/2006 winter period, the cost of gas will also reflect the Gas Hedging Plan approved by the CPUC in Decision D05-10-043.

Baseline Allowance (therms per day): (Effective 07/01/02)

1.546 - Winter: Nov. 1 to Apr. 30, inclusive

0.493 - Summer: May 1 to Oct. 31, inclusive

* A therm equals approximately 100,000 British Thermal Units which is approx. 100 cubic feet.
